ADULTS - A verse by verse study of the book of Philippians.

ADULTS - This adult Bible class explores one of the assigned lectionary readings for the day. Each week, we will study a selected Gospel, Epistle, Old Testament, or Psalm reading to deepen our **understanding of God's Word and its place in our worship.**

FOCUS - A small group that goes through the Bible, one book, one chapter, one verse at a time. Our mission is to lead a comprehensive understanding of the Word of God.

GMC – Growing Marriages in Christ is a Bible study and fellowship group for married couples. Most participants have high school, college age, or young adult children. In this small group discussion study, we will discover how the book of Psalms powerfully resonates with the whole spectrum of human emotions and experiences. We will explore **the Bible's ability to transform our emotions and incline our hearts toward worship.**

MOSAICS - Messiah Mosaics is a class geared at anyone in their 30s or 40s, married or single. This is a discussion-based class that examines how God's Word influences our daily walk with Christ.

YOUNG ADULTS - This is a class for adults in college or in the work force, ages 18-29.

THE NEST - The NEST stands for: Nurturing-Encouraging-Supporting-Teaching. This class is currently comprised of young parents and young adults.

THE CHOSEN - This class led by Gina Lehrmann will watch episodes of The Chosen and follow a study about the biblical events that take place during the episodes.

In February, we celebrate Ash Wednesday marking the beginning of the 40-day Lenten season (excluding Sundays) that leads to Easter Sunday on April 5, 2026.

The LCMS emphasizes that Lent is a season of repentance, reflection, and renewal. The Lenten message for this season often centers on God's steadfast love in Christ, calling believers to turn away from sin and live in the hope of the resurrection. Lent is not about earning God's favor, but about remembering what Christ has already done and walking daily in repentance and faith.

By actively embracing these practices, Lenten observance becomes a season of spiritual growth, preparation for celebrating Christ's resurrection, and living our faith through service and mercy.

Messiah's Men's Ministry begins its 3rd year with continued focus on being in God's Word daily as well as emphasizing daily prayer time where we can spend time 1 on 1 with our Lord.

Tai Chi strengthens the mind and spirit and regulates the central nervous system to relieve stress. Tai Chi is a preventative exercise for people of all ages.

This is a low-impact, slow-motion exercise with movements usually circular and never forced, the muscles are relaxed rather than tensed, the joints are not fully extended and bent.
