ADULTS - A study of how great Heaven will be.

ADULTS - This adult Bible class explores one of the assigned lectionary readings for the day. Each week, we will study a selected Gospel, Epistle, Old Testament, or Psalm reading to deepen our **understanding of God's Word and its place in our worship.**

FOCUS - A small group that goes through the Bible, one book, one chapter, one verse at a time. Our mission is to lead a comprehensive understanding of the Word of God.

GMC – Growing Marriages in Christ is a Bible study and fellowship group for married couples. Most participants have high school, college age, or young adult children. In this small group discussion study, we are studying the video series *Seeking Allah, Finding Jesus* by the late Nabeel Qureshi, a former devout Muslim. This series explains how he converted to Christianity and explores Muslim culture, common objections to Christianity, and provides Christian apologetics for sharing the Gospel with Muslims.

MOSAICS - Messiah Mosaics is a class geared at anyone in their 30s or 40s, married or single. This is a discussion-based class that examines how God's Word influences our daily walk with Christ.

YOUNG ADULTS - This is a class for adults in college or in the work force, ages 18-29.

THE NEST - The NEST stands for: Nurturing-Encouraging-Supporting-Teaching. This class is currently comprised of young parents and young adults.

THE CHOSEN - This class led by Gina Lehrmann will watch episodes of The Chosen and follow a study about the biblical events that take place during the episodes.

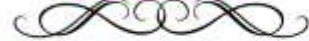

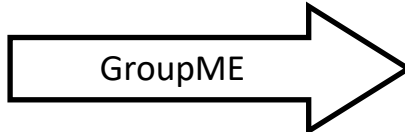
