

PHISHING SCAM EMAILS

Periodically, fraudulent emails are sent out posing as someone on our staff here at Messiah. We have received many calls and emails regarding the most recent "Phishing" email scam, and we want to warn you to dismiss these attempts to lure you in to giving money and/or information. It's likely you receive these from other people and/or organizations in your address book, but we want to make sure you know that the Staff of Messiah



Lutheran Church in Plano, Texas will **NEVER** send you an email wanting to discuss a discreet matter and/or request monetary assistance without explanation and especially discouraging you from contacting us. You can also trust that our IT company has our network secured, and these scams are coming from an outside source making it difficult to trace them and report them to the proper authorities. If we want to discuss something of that nature with you, we will call you and speak with you personally. Just because the email address looks like it is official and maybe even has a picture of the person, this does not make it legitimate. If you receive an email like this in the future, please check the return email address and be advised that most of the staff email addresses end in @messiahlutheran.com. Pastor Kollmann only has one email address, victor@messiahlutheran.com. We do not want you to become a victim of this type of crime so please

simply delete any suspicious emails.

- Emails with bad grammar and spelling mistakes.
- Emails with an unfamiliar greeting or salutation, such as addressing you by your first and last name.
- Inconsistencies in email addresses, links & domain names.
- Suspicious attachments.
- Emails requesting login credentials, payment information or sensitive data.
