GOD'S PLAN OF SALVATION--A book by book study through the entire Bible.

THE UPPER ROOM—In this adult Bible class, we will learn about the basic teachings of the Lutheran faith. Whether you are a lifelong Lutheran searching for more information or new to being a Lutheran, we will make connections between what Lutherans believe and what Lutherans do.

FOCUS—is a small group that goes through the Bible, one book, one chapter, one verse at a time. Our mission is to lead a comprehensive understanding of the Word of God.

GMC- Growing Marriages in Christ is a Bible study and fellowship group for married couples. Most participants have high school, college age, or young adult children. The current study is based on a book by Lee Niehuis. "It is easy to look at the world and feel overwhelmed, but you don't need to

lose hope." Lee's book teaches us to embrace God's calling and gives us confidence to know that God will empower us to live out our faith in the world.

MOSAICS-Messiah Mosaics is a class geared at anyone in their 30s or 40s, married or single. This is a discussion-based class that examines how God's Word influences our daily walk with Christ.

YOUNG ADULTS-This is a class for adults in college or in the work force, ages 18-29.

THE CHOSEN-This class led by Gina Lehrmann will watch episodes of The Chosen and follow a study about the biblical events that take place during the episodes.

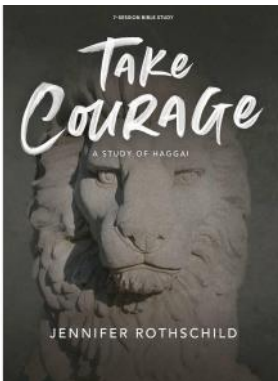

Our school Mitchell Elementary has approximately 780 students with over 50 % economically disadvantaged. We have many students whose families cannot afford to provide a snack for their students. 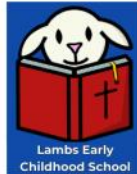

This is an low-pact, slow-motion exercise with movements usually circular and never forced, the muscles are relaxed rather than tensed, the joints are not fully extended and bent.
