**GOD'S PLAN OF SALVATION**--A book by book study through the entire Bible.

**THE UPPER ROOM**—In this adult Bible class, we will learn about the basic teachings of the Lutheran faith. Whether you are a lifelong Lutheran searching for more information or new to being a Lutheran, we will make connections between what Lutherans believe and what Lutherans do.

**FOCUS**—is a small group that goes through the Bible, one book, one chapter, one verse at a time. Our mission is to lead a comprehensive understanding of the Word of God.

**GMC**- Growing Marriages in Christ is a Bible study and fellowship group for married couples. Most participants have high school, college age, or young adult children. The current study is based on a book by Lee Niehuis. "It is easy to look at the world and feel overwhelmed, but you don't need to

lose hope." Lee's book teaches us to embrace God's calling and gives us confidence to know that God will empower us to live out our faith in the world.

**MOSAICS**-Messiah Mosaics is a class geared at anyone in their 30s or 40s, married or single. This is a discussion-based class that examines how God's Word influences our daily walk with Christ.

**YOUNG ADULTS**-This is a class for adults in college or in the work force, ages 18-29.

**THE CHOSEN**-This class led by Gina Lehrmann will watch episodes of The Chosen and follow a study about the biblical events that take place during the episodes.

**MEET MESSIAH**-If you would like to know about Messiah, meet at the Guest Information Desk at 9:30am. A few of our members will take you on a tour of our campus and answer questions you may have about our church.

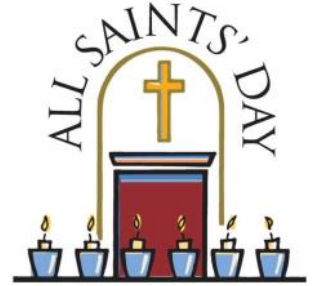

## HEROES ON THE WATER



When I retired, I considered several volunteer opportunities beyond my involvement with Messiah. A friend in Allen approached me about a program he had experimented with at Brooke's Army Medical Center working with wounded veterans. That program was Heroes on the Water, a nonprofit organization founded in Allen some 16 years ago. The initial mission was to take wounded veterans kayak fishing at no cost to the veteran. My passion for fishing and an opportunity to serve our veteran community resulted in my

volunteering to help get the program going. I've now led the DFW Chapter for 14 plus years. The program was soon expanded to any veteran and their family members. Now the program includes first responders. I have a great group of volunteers including Art Arnold and Stephen Guittard as my key support helpers. I am blessed in that I have access to some terrific private lakes where the participants can enjoy a day on the water without the noise and traffic of boats and jet skis, plus they can catch fish. We hold one day events March – October on Saturdays and occasionally mid-week for small groups.

As the years have passed, Heroes on the Water has been as much a blessing to me as it has been to those veterans and first responders who are served. The peaceful on the water environment soothes troubled souls. Many participants have reported how the impact of the organization has changed their lives and the lives of their families.
